WHAT SIZE IS THE BEAR?

Each bear sculpture measures -Height: 2.11m, Width: 79.4cm, Depth: 77.7cm

ARE THE PLINTHS AVAILABLE TO DISPLAY THE BEARS ON?

Each bear sculpture is sold without the concrete /steel plinth which it was displayed on throughout the trail.

WHERE IS THE AUCTION?

The Crucible Theatre, 55 Norfolk Street, Sheffield, S1 1DA.

WHAT TIME DOES IT START AND END?

Registration for bidding begins at 4.00pm with a drink's reception until 5.50pm. The auction will start promptly at 6.00pm and we expect the auction to finish at approximately 11.00pm.

HOW DO I GET A TICKET FOR THE AUCTION? You can book tickets direct with

the Crucible Theatre, Sheffield, by visiting their website at www. sheffieldtheatres.co.uk/events/bears-of-sheffield-auction, by phoning the Box Office on 0114 249 6000 or by visiting the Box Office in person at the Crucible Theatre, 55 Norfolk Street, Sheffield, S1 1DA. The Box Office is open from 12.00-8.00pm, with phone lines closing at 7.00pm. On non-show days, the Box Office will be open from 12.00-6.00pm.

CAN I REGISTER TO BID AT THE AUCTION IN ADVANCE?

Yes, to manage the arrangements of the auction as efficiently as possible, you can request a registration form prior to the event night. Fill this out and bring this along with you on the night along with a form of photographic identification. Please request this rom sculptures@tchc.org.uk

WHAT CAN I DO IF I CAN'T MAKE IT TO THE CRUCIBLE?

Telephone, proxy and online bidding will be available if you are unable to attend the auction in person. For telephone or proxy bidding please request a bidding form from The Children's Hospital Charity by emailing sculptures@tchc.org.uk with 'Auction Enquiry' as the subject.

WHAT IS A TELEPHONE BID?

If you can't attend the auction you can still take part in the bidding by preselecting which Bear(s) you would like to bid for and how much you are willing to pay. Please state your preferred payment method when you submit your bid on the Telephone Bidding Form. You will be required to provide a copy of your passport/ driving licence and a recent utilities bill (from the last three months). We will call you before your lot is due so that you can speak to a member of the auction team live in the auction room and instruct us to bid for you. If you are

successful with your bid, you will be contacted after your chosen lot has closed to confirm your preferred payment method.



WHAT IS A PROXY BID?

If you can't attend the auction you can still take part in the bidding. You can select which Bear(s) you would like to bid for and how much you are willing to pay and your preferred payment method when you submit your bid on the Proxy Bidding Form.

You will be required to provide a copy of your passport/driving licence and a recent utilities bill (from the last three months). A member of the auction team will be authorised to bid on your behalf to your specified limit. If you are successful with your bid, you will be contacted after your chosen lot has closed to confirm your preferred payment method.

IF MY BID IS SUCCESSFUL, HOW DO I PAY FOR MY BEAR?

You can pay by cheque and most major debit and credit cards.
Sculptures will not be released until payment has been cleared.
