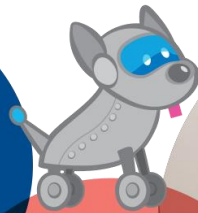

£10,000 **RESEARCH INTO** **PHYSICAL ACTIVITY** **IN CANCER PATIENTS**

The results could influence and change the national guidance for cancer treatment.



EMBROIDERY **MACHINE £1,800**

Used by the therapy team to add images to pressure garments for burns patients.

TINY TRAX **MOTORISED** **WHEELCHAIR** for Ryegate Centre **£8,224**

BATHING **LIFT** **TROLLEY** Ward 5 **£5,000**

Helps to transfer and bath patients who need to remain laid down.



£850,000 **SAFEGUARDING** **SUPPORT UNIT**

The unit supports children and young people where there have been safeguarding concerns. Thanks to your donations we were able to make it more comfortable, brighter and add interactive artwork for children.



£470,000 **NEW INTEGRATED** **THEATRES**

The new theatres will dramatically improve endoscopic surgery and enable operations to be broadcast internationally, helping surgeons across the world.



£28,000 **ARTHROSCOPY** **STACKER**

This equipment assists our clinicians who are performing knee surgery. Sheffield Children's is known as a centre of excellence for this kind of surgery.

PARENT **PAGING** **SYSTEM** **FOR PACU** **£6,120**

This lets parents know when their child is in the recovery room after an operation.

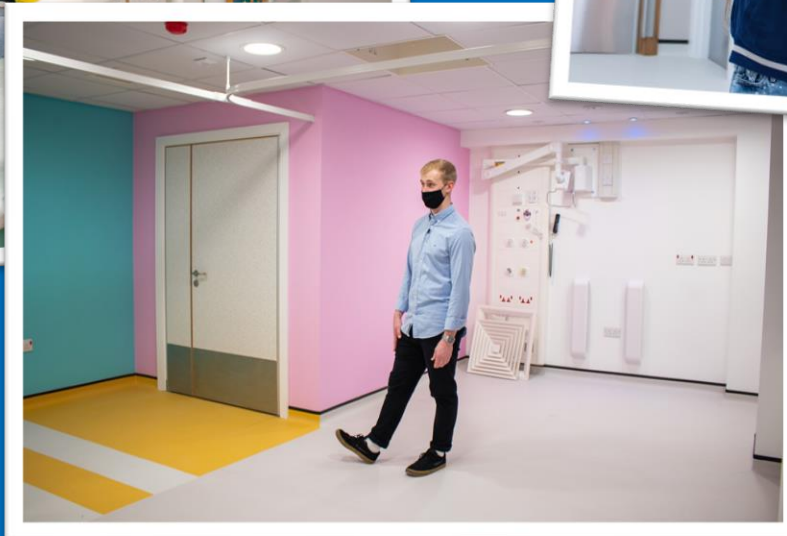
Create a new Emergency Department with more space for treatment, better facilities for our major trauma patients and isolation suites for when patients need specialist care immediately.

CANCER & LEUKAEMIA WARD

- ✓ Raised £2.75million to deliver a transformed ward
- ✓ Created 10 new bedrooms, a 4 bed and 2 bed bay with state-of-the-art facilities
- ✓ Every bed has an accompanying parent bed
- ✓ Loads of storage space!
- ✓ Installed an interactive playroom in a flexible space
- ✓ Reconfigured the layout to maximize on space
- ✓ Brought the outside in with views of the park



SAFEGUARDING SUPPORT UNIT

- ✓ Raised £1million to build new SSU facilities
- ✓ The facility was sensitively developed to support children and young people where there have been safeguarding concerns
- ✓ With Megaverse, Artfelt created an interactive colour wall
- ✓ Brand new facilities which are calming for the patients that visit



HELIPAD AND MAJOR TRAUMA CENTRE

- ☐ Build a new Helipad on the roof of Sheffield Children's
- ☐ Add floodlighting for safe landing
- ☐ Create a clear pathway from the Helipad into the Emergency Department
- ☐ Expand the size of the Emergency Department to accommodate more patients
