National Citizen Service in South Yorkshire in 2021, helped us build a better future for patients on our Cancer Ward.

Through fundraising events like charity quizzes, sponsored walks, circus activities and cake sales the 2021 NCS teams donated over \pounds 7,000 towards the new ward which opened at the end of last year.

Sheffield Children's Hospital is a designated Major Trauma Centre, which means we need to get patients who urgently need critical care to our Emergency Department as soon as possible. It really is the difference between life and death.

Currently, air ambulances can only land in daytime hours at Weston Park with some Helicopter Emergency Medical Services not wanting to land due to an inadequate landing site.



Once landed the patient is met by Sheffield Children's specially trained Major Trauma team and transferred by stretcher across the busy main road to ED. This is the one time we don't want children waiting for the green man.

Help us build a helipad on the roof of the hospital so we can transfer children safely and privately to our specialist major trauma unit.

Planning your Event

What?

What activity or activities will you be doing during your week? What resources or equipment will you need?

Who?

Allocate roles within your team and decide who is doing which task. Make sure you are using members' strengths or why not try something new? Also bear in mind who you are aiming your fundraising at.

Where?

Think about where your activities will take place. Do you need to get permission from the venue or land owner? Do you need a license if it is on public property? Please note a license can take up to 28 days to be approved. Please check your local council website for more information on licenses.

Why?

People may ask you about who you are fundraising for so it's always good to remember some key facts about the charity.

When?

When will your activity take place? Have you given yourself enough time to plan, collect fundraising materials and apply for any licenses needed?

How?

Are there costs involved? How will your activity bring in money? What can the charity provide to help with your event?

If you would like to do a bank transfer, please let us know and we can provide you with the details.
